

COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("AGREEMENT") entered into this 30th day of JANUARY, 2007 by and between **THE EVANGELINE PARISH POLICE JURY** ("POLICE JURY"), herein represented by its duly appointed President, William Guidry, whose address is 200 Court Street, Suite 207, Ville Platte, Louisiana 70586, as per Resolution of the Police Jury authorizing his action; and **TOWN OF MAMOU**, (**TOWN**), herein represented by its Honorable Wilda Chamberlain, whose address is P.O. Box 490, Mamou, Louisiana 70554.

Whereas the **TOWN** for public purpose desires assistance for the implementation and enforcement of the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code.

THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1.

The **TOWN** and the **POLICE JURY**, in conjunction with each other agree that the implementation, inspection and permitting and enforcement of the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code be provided by the **POLICE JURY** for construction of buildings and other structures, as required by the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code, within the corporate limits of the **TOWN**.

It is further agreed that either party may terminate the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement at any time and without cause upon written notice delivered to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to date of termination.
